- ◆ Bullying of any kind
- ◆ Physical violence
- ◆ Damage to property or theft



Rising Expectations

As students grow up they have...

- ◆ Increasing responsibility
- ◆ The ability to choose more positive actions
- ◆ Increasing consequences for unacceptable conduct



Consequences

Logical consequences are the responses to unacceptable conduct. Consequences...

- ◆ Are based on the type, severity and frequency of unacceptable conduct
- ◆ Will be appropriate for the situation
- ◆ Will be appropriate for the student's age

Responses to unacceptable conduct...

- ◆ Immediate intervention
- ◆ Removal from the situation
- ◆ Completion of belief reminder sheet
- ◆ Discussion of lesson learned
- ◆ Small incident playground report
- ◆ Critical incident report
- ◆ Referral to Principal

Notification

Serious unacceptable behavior can result in advising...

- ◆ Parents of offending student
- ◆ Parents of victim
- ◆ District officials, as required by policy
- ◆ Police/other agencies, as required by law
